Maintenance: Maintain in the conventional manner by cleaning with a treated yarn dust mop to remove surface dirt daily. Damp mop or clean with an automatic scrubber as required, using an approved neutral cleaner at the specified dilution. Spray buffing to remove embedded soils is recommended. Worn areas, or the entire floor, may be recoated as required to maintain a uniform high gloss. When stripping becomes necessary use an approved stripper for detergent resistant finishes.

Floor Preparation: Strip floor of old finish and wax, paying particular attention to baseboards, corners, under furniture, and built up areas. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and allow to completely dry. Application: If desired one or two coats of an approved sealer may be used, prior to finish application. Using a clean mop or applicator apply a thin uniform coat of finish. Allow to dry for a minimum of 20 minutes after each coat. Do not apply more than 4 coats in a 24 hour

period. Floor should be thoroughly dry before traffic is allowed in area. Spray Buff: To restore original luster, polish with an approved spray buff compound or laminator.

High Speed Burnishing: This is an ideal product for use with high speed polishing or burnishing machines of 1000 rpm or higher. The floor should first be damp mopped with a suitable neutral cleaner and allowed to dry. The surface may then, as desired, be dry burnished with a high speed white or tan buffing pad, or using the same equipment, be spray buffed using an approved product. An alternate method, for insuring a long lasting durable surface, would be to apply an approved mop-on restorer or laminator, allow to dry and then to follow the dry buffing procedure. Floor finish can also be polished by auto scrub method.

Maintenance: Maintain in the conventional manner by cleaning with a treated yarn dust mop to remove surface dirt daily. Damp mop or clean with an automatic scrubber as required, using an approved neutral cleaner at the specified dilution. Spray buffing to remove embedded soils is recommended. Worn areas, or the entire floor, may be recoated as required to maintain a uniform high gloss. When stripping becomes necessary use an approved stripper for detergent resistant finishes.
